



MDU Conditions of use:

West Yorkshire Scouts shall lend the MDU to Scout Group / Scout Association member listed on the booking form on the following terms and conditions only:

- The borrow period shall commence on the day detailed on the booking or the day of pickup whichever is sooner. The borrow period ends when the MDU has been returned to Bradley Wood and condition inspected.
- A minimum 30 day notice period is required for all bookings and the MDU is to be booked through the booking form on the County Website.
- To be collected and returned to Bradley Wood Campsite (Shepherds Thorn Lane, Brighouse, HD6 3TU) by the borrower within the agreed booking dates, details of the access arrangements will be advised once the use is confirmed.
- To be inspected by the borrower on pickup from Bradley, any defects found during use to be reported on return to the County Office.
- West Yorkshire Scout reserves the right to cancel any booking without notice (and take back the MDU at an event) should it be deemed necessary by the County, West Yorkshire Scouts will not be liable for any loss or expenses incurred as a result of the cancellation.
- West Yorkshire Scouts reserves the right to remove any equipment (Optional or standard) without notice from a booking should it be deemed necessary by the County, West Yorkshire Scouts will not be liable for any loss or expenses incurred as a result of the cancellation
- No liability shall attach to West Yorkshire Scouts for loss or damage to the borrowers own goods or equipment as a result of borrowing the MDU. West Yorkshire scouts does not accept any liability for any damage or injury to goods or persons caused by the misuse of the MDU
- It is the duty of the borrower to provide a duly authorised Scout Association member at Bradley Wood to collect and return the MDU at the pre advised date and time and hand in these signed terms and conditions.
- It is the borrower's responsibility to ensure the towing vehicle is adequate for the task, the driver is competent and qualified to tow and has adequate insurance cover. Whilst on a public road the MDU must be insured under the borrowers insurance policy. In addition the towing vehicle must be capable of towing 1500kgs but not exceed (together MDU and passengers) 3500kgs.
- When in the borrowers possession and parked up the MDU must be secured at all times with the 2 wheel locks and lockable hitch over the towing hitch to comply with the insurance policy.
- The borrower is solely responsible for the MDU and any damages occurred during the period of the booking. The borrower undertakes to keep the MDU in good order and condition and to return with all equipment in such order and condition. In the event of any article being damaged and requiring repair, the borrower will pay the full cost of such repair. If items are damaged beyond repair and require replacement, the borrower will pay the full cost of the replacement. The MDU will be inspected on return to Bradley Wood.
- If any items of equipment in the MDU or the MDU itself is not returned by the borrower to Bradley Wood at the end of the agreed borrow period then the borrower will be invoiced for the full amount of the equipment not returned.
- No personal belongings or non MDU equipment should be carried or stored in the MDU as this may damage the MDU and equipment in transit.
- The generator will be fully fuelled on collection, to be returned fully fuelled.
