Booking Forms

Every Group will need to complete a Group Booking Form on bookwhen and complete a participant spreadsheet, Leaders will also need to hold a completed health form for all participants. Anyone without the required paperwork will be unable to attend the event.

Closing Date

The closing date for booking on to the Camp is Friday 17th December.

Cost

The Camp cost for Participants is £40pp – this includes camping fees, meals, activities, a camp t-shirt and camp badge. The cost for Leaders will be £10pp – this includes camping fees, meals and a camp badge. Cheques should be made payable to 'Bradley Wood' and for card payments please call 01484 715858.

Group Equipment

It is the Leaders responsibility to provide an adequate kit list and to ensure that the Participants are prepared for the Camp. The camp will supply toilet and washing facilities, shelter on activities where appropriate, communal shelters with alter fires in camping areas and covered eating areas. Please note that the event organisers are not responsible for the damage or loss of any equipment brought to the event – please ensure that adequate insurance cover is in place.

Accommodation

There are there 3 camping pods available to book at £50 per night, in addition to the camp fee, sleeping a maximum of 5 people per pod under the current guidelines. If you would like to book please enquire about the availability. Camping areas will be allocated on arrival – please bear in mind that you will be camping close to other groups and your space will be limited. Infection Control

The event will be run in line with the current government and Scouting guidelines at the time of the event. This may lead to changes being made at short notice.

Home Contact NAN

Please ensure that you have followed the rules and guidelines laid out in POR with regards to home contact and notification of nights away to your DC. You will need to have a Leader with a camping permit in attendance.

Arrival at the event

Due to the number of marshalls arriving and leaving the site, vehicles will be on duty to relieve congestion and oversee parking. Vehicles must be left in the car parks throughout the weekend. Where possible and in line with the current guidelines please encourage car sharing.

Medication

All medication for participants must be stored in a container and clearly marked with the name and dosage information of the recipient. The contingent leader is responsible for the safe keeping and administering of any medication required by participants.

Lost Property

Lost property will be kept on site for two weeks, after that time all lost property will be donated to charity.

Departure from the event

Groups will be allocated a leaving time and cars will not be permitted on site until all activities are finished.
